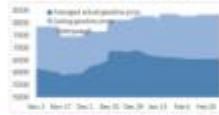

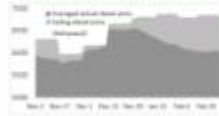

### China eyes gas output hike on expected double-digit consumption growth

China plans to generate around 170 billion cubic meters of natural gas in 2017, 22.9 billion cubic meters or 23.99 percent higher than that in 2016, according to an annual work plan for 2017 issued by the National Energy Administration (NEA) on February 13.

Meanwhile, the NEA expected national natural gas consumption would increase to 190.05 billion cubic meters in 2017, 11.83 percent or 24.55 billion cubic meters higher than that in 2016.

The share of natural gas in national primary energy consumption would increase to around 6.3 percent from 6.27 percent in 2016. By contrast, the share of natural gas in primary energy consumption only grew by 0.6 percentage point in 2016, 0.3 percentage point in 2015 and 0.4 percentage point in 2014.

China would only produce 168.8 billion cubic meters of natural gas in 2017 up 2.09 percent year on year and national natural gas consumption would rise 5.9 percent to 190.05 billion cubic meters in 2017, according to latest estimate by CNPC Economic and Technology Research Institute.

In particular, Chinese output of shale gas would rise to around 16 billion cubic meters in 2017 up from 5.5 billion cubic meters in 2016. China aims to add 3.3 billion cubic meters of shale gas production capacity in the year.

Demonstration on industrial biogas projects would be pushed forward in Heilongjiang and Beijing, which would help sustain recycling economy at county level.

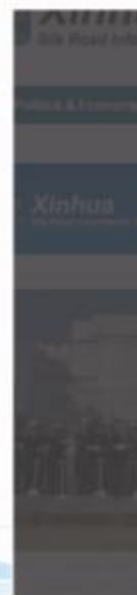

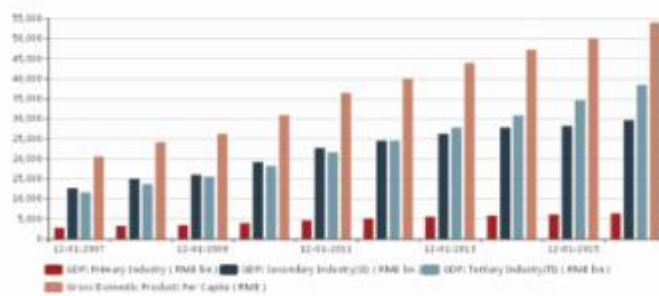
